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Definitions

Academic Year – The Academic Year (AY) includes Fall, Spring, and Summer terms of overlapping calendar

years. This differs from the reporting year, which begins with summer and ends with spring. Unless otherwise indicated, the NFC Fact Book uses the Academic Year. Trends use the last 5 Academic Years.

2023-2024 Fact Book:

AY 2024 = Fall 2023, Spring 2024, Summer 2024

AY 2023 = Fall 2022, Spring 2023, Summer 2023

AY 2022 = Fall 2021, Spring 2022, Summer 2022

AY 2021 = Fall 2020, Spring 2021, Summer 2021

AY 2020 = Fall 2019, Spring 2020, Summer 2020

College Credit – The type of credit assigned to courses that are part of an organized and specified college degree or program.

Credit Hour – The number of contact hours for a course.

Dual Enrollment – Enrollment in two institutions at the same time, such as a college and high school, which allows students to earn both high school and college credit simultaneously.

Duplicated Headcount – A headcount measure by which students may be counted in more than one category. This measure usually describes the number of seats taken across multiple courses or number of degrees or certificates awarded.

First Time in College (FTIC) – Students attending college for the first time with no prior credit toward a degree nor any formal award. FTIC includes students applying for the first time after high school graduation who have dual enrollment credit earned during high school.

Full-time Equivalency (FTE) – The number of full-time equivalent students is the number of college credits divided by 30 credit hours OR the number of non-college credit instruction divided by 900 contact/clock hours (FAC 6A-14.076).

Full-time Student – A student who is registered for 12 or more credit hours.

Part-time Student – A student who is registered for less than 12 credit hours.


Reporting Year – The summer, fall, and spring terms of overlapping calendar years. For example, Summer 2023, Fall 2023, and Spring 2024 comprise the 2023-2024 reporting year. This differs from the academic year, which begins with fall and ends with summer.

Unduplicated Headcount – A headcount measure by which students are counted in only one category.

Service Area

North Florida College is located in Madison, Florida at 325 NW Turner Davis Drive. Madison lies in the center of NFC's six county service area (Hamilton, Jefferson, Lafayette, Madison, Suwannee, and Taylor Counties), off of I-10 near I-75, and is near such major Florida cities as Tallahassee and Jacksonville. NFC is also just minutes away from the Georgia border and is a short distance from the Gulf of Mexico and cities bordering the Atlantic Ocean.

The City of Madison has a population of just under 3,000; Madison County's total population is close to 18,500; and NFC's six-county service area has a combined population of over 121,000 (figures based on 2020 census data from the US Census Bureau).




Dual Enrollment Count by Registration Status

Percentage of DE Students by Term






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Dual Enrollment Trend

Dual Enrollment by Registration Status






Dual Enrolled Students Total Enrollment



Enrollment by Ethnicity Academic Year 2023-24







Enrollment by Gender Academic Year 2023-24






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Enrollment by County Academic Year 2023-24








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Enrollment by Student Type






Graduates by Ethnicity Academic Year 2023-24





Graduates by Gender Academic Year 2023-24





Graduates by Age Group Academic Year 2023-24




Number of Graduates by Age Group






5 Year Trend: Graduates by County Other FL Out of State

Financial Aid Amount Awarded








Percent Enrolled Receiving Financial Aid by County







Remote Hybrid: (blend of face-to-face + synchronous online) course meets face-to-face on the indicated day(s)/time & synchronous online on a specific day/time


HyFlex: This type of course allows for a flexible participation structure whereby students may choose to attend face-to-face synchronous class sessions in person (physically attending class) or online without physically attending class. 

5 Year Trend: Courses by Modality






























Average Overall Term GPA by Ethnicity




Average Overall Term GPA by County
